Predictive Modeling of Housing Prices using Multiple Regression Analysis UIUC
Course Project for Statistics 3##: Regression Analysis Fall 2023

- Researched datasets available via the university library to collect information on various housing-related variables, such as square footage, number of bedrooms, and neighborhood characteristics
- Conducted exploratory data analysis to identify potential predictors and assess multicollinearity
- Used R to build a multiple regression model that explained a significant portion of the variance in housing prices
- Presented findings in a clear and accessible manner, highlighting the model's predictive capabilities

Analysis of Customer Satisfaction Survey Data UIUC
Course Project for Statistics 2##: Statistical Analysis Applications Spring 2023

- Used SAS to clean raw quantitative survey data from a dataset of 1,000+ responses, ensuring accuracy and consistency
- Analyzed descriptive statistics to summarize key metrics, such as mean satisfaction scores and response distributions
- Conducted hypothesis testing to assess the significance of factors influencing customer satisfaction
- Created visualizations, including bar charts and scatter plots, to effectively communicate results to a non-technical audience

Technology skills are both listed together in one section (to provide an overview) and integrated into position descriptions (to show action and impact).
